Tom Smith retired in 2001 after 23 years teaching Maths, 15 as Head of Department. After HM Customs and Excise, he turned his hand to teaching and was a natural, encouraging young Bancroftians to enjoy Maths. He wanted

He ran an effective Department, with sound administration and clear leadership. He was a great supporter of School events, especially Badminton, and was a regular promoter of the School at open days, concerts and plays.
